## INSTRUCTIONS

(Attachment to the CSIR-NGRI Notice No. NGRI-7/6/2014-Rectt. dated 3<sup>rd</sup> April, 2017)

1. The candidates were screened on the basis of information provided by them in their respective applications. It may be noted that the candidature of the shortlisted candidates is provisional subject to satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. In the event of any of the information being found false or incorrect or any ineligibility being detected before or after the selection, the candidature of the concerned candidate is liable to be cancelled and action can be initiated accordingly against him / her.
2. The date for determining qualifications and/or experience shall be the closing date prescribed for submission of online application i.e. 17.10.2014.
3. In respect of equivalent clause in Essential Qualifications, if a candidate is claiming a particular qualification as equivalent qualification as per the requirement of advertisement, then the candidate is required to produce order/letter in this regard, indicating the Authority (with number and date) under which it has been so treated, otherwise his / her candidature is liable to be rejected.
4. Candidates are required to bring the following Certificates in Original for verification and also one set of self-attested photocopies at the time of Interview:
  - a) Matriculation certificate / mark sheet for date of birth. No other document relating to age will be accepted.
  - b) All certificates of educational qualifications along with mark sheets of all the academic years.
  - c) Experience certificates.
  - d) Certificate in support of claim to belong to Scheduled Caste / Scheduled Tribes / Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer) / PWD [wherever applicable] in the format (s) prescribed in connection with employment in Govt. of India.
  - e) An Affidavit, if there is difference in either name/father's name or spelling of name/father's name in all the Certificates and application form.
  - f) No Objection Certificate – in case employed in CSIR Labs / Government Department / Autonomous Bodies / Public Sector Undertakings
5. In case of claims regarding change in name after matriculation on marriage or remarriage, divorce etc., the following documents shall be submitted:
  - a) In case of marriage of women – Photocopy of Husband's passport showing name of spouse or an attested copy of marriage certificate issued by the Registrar of Marriage or an affidavit from husband and wife along with a joint photograph duly sworn before the Oath Commissioner.
  - b) In case of re-marriage of women – Divorce Deed / Death Certificate as the case may be in r/o first spouse; and photocopy of present husband's passport showing name of spouse or an attested copy of marriage certificate issued by the Registrar of Marriage or an Affidavit from the husband and wife along with joint photograph duly sworn before the Oath Commissioner.

- c) In case of divorce of women – Certified copy of Divorce Decree and Deed Poll / Affidavit duly sworn before the Oath Commissioner.
  - d) In other circumstances for change of name for both male and female – Deed Poll / Affidavit duly sworn before the Oath Commissioner and paper cutting of two leading daily newspaper in original (one daily newspaper should be at the area of applicants permanent and present or nearby area) and Gazette Notification.
6. Candidates claiming age-relaxation as widow should produce Death Certificate of her husband together with the Affidavit that she has not remarried since. Divorced Women or Women judicially separated from their husbands, should produce a certified copy of the judgment/decree of the appropriate court to prove the fact of divorce or judicial separation as the case may be and the Divorcee should produce along with an Affidavit that she has not remarried since.
  7. Candidates claiming age-relaxation as a domicile of the state of Jammu and Kashmir should produce a certificate from the District Magistrate in the State of Jammu and Kashmir within whose jurisdiction he / she had ordinarily resided or from any other authority designated in that behalf by the Government of Jammu & Kashmir to the effect that he / she had ordinarily been domiciled in the State of Jammu and Kashmir during the period from 1<sup>st</sup> January 1980 to 31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1989.
  8. Upper age limit is relaxable up to five years for the regular employees working in Government Departments, autonomous bodies and public sector undertakings. The candidate has to produce the service certificate, issued after the date of advertisement from his / her employer on Office's letter head, showing the details of the total service rendered in regular capacity. Minimum three (3) years of regular service is required to be rendered to get age relaxation of five (5) years.
  9. In case of Universities/Institute awarding CGPA/SGPA/OGPA grades etc., candidates are requested to convert the same into percentage based on the formula as per their University/Institute and shall produce Order / Certificate to this effect from concerned authority.
  10. Candidates are also advised to read carefully the contents of CSIR-NGRI Advt. No.1/2014.
  11. Only outstation candidates (within India) who attend interview will be paid to and fro single sleeper class rail fare from the actual place of undertaking the journey or from the normal place of their residence whichever is nearer to the **Secunderabad Railway Station** on production of Rail Tickets/Rail Ticket Numbers or any other proof of journey. For road journeys between stations not connected by rail, the actual bus fare or road mileage at the lowest rate as admissible under rules, will be reimbursed, on production of documentary proof (bus tickets) and provided that the distance covered by road is more than 20 miles each way.
  12. Outstation candidates are advised to make arrangements for lodging and boarding on their own.

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
